

# Classic Scotland - 8 nights

Edinburgh, with its famous castle and 'Royal Mile' is the starting point for this tour which uncovers many famous Scottish towns. Travel North via St Andrews with its university and golf courses and visit Pitlochry with the salmon ladder before continuing to Inverness. Here the Culloden battlefield is well worth a visit, as are a couple of the malt whisky distilleries and the 'Black Isle' but leave time for some serious 'monster hunting' to try and spot Nessie!



Travel South via the beautiful West coast of Argyll via Oban with views to the islands, then cross the 'Arrochar Alps' to tranquil Loch Lomond and the Trossach hills.

- 2 nights Edinburgh/Fife
- 2 nights Inverness / Muir of Ord
- 2 nights Fort William
- 2 nights Trossachs / Loch Lomond

A logical extension to this tour would be a night or two on the Isle of Skye, the road bridge is now free to cross, but be warned that the island gets very booked up in July and August. Alternatively, why not try our Scotland Grand Tour which offers 12 nights exploration.
