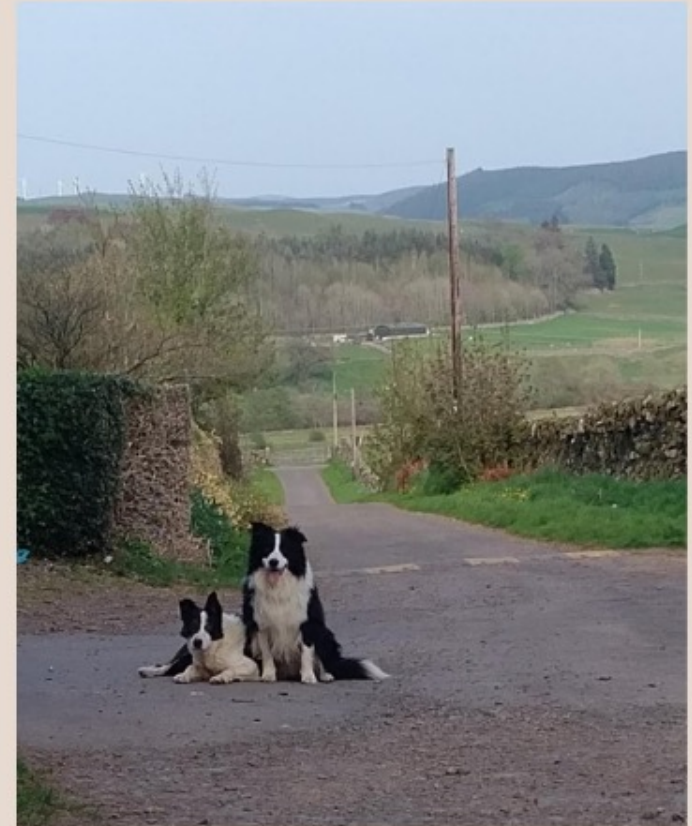
It is a holiday – allow yourself time to relax and enjoy it!
